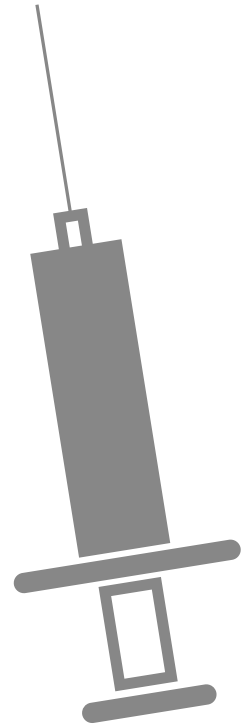

1 Drug Related Waste and Litter

Drug related waste and litter to include injecting equipment is hazardous. If you come across any drug related waste or litter eg. a used syringe or spoon, **do not attempt to remove it yourself**. Drug related waste and litter needs to be disposed of by people who know how.



2 What do I do if I get a Needlestick Injury?

Needlestick injuries are wounds caused by needles that accidentally puncture the skin. If you get a needlestick injury you need to contact your local Accident and Emergency Department.

3 What do I do if I find Drug Related Waste and Litter?
